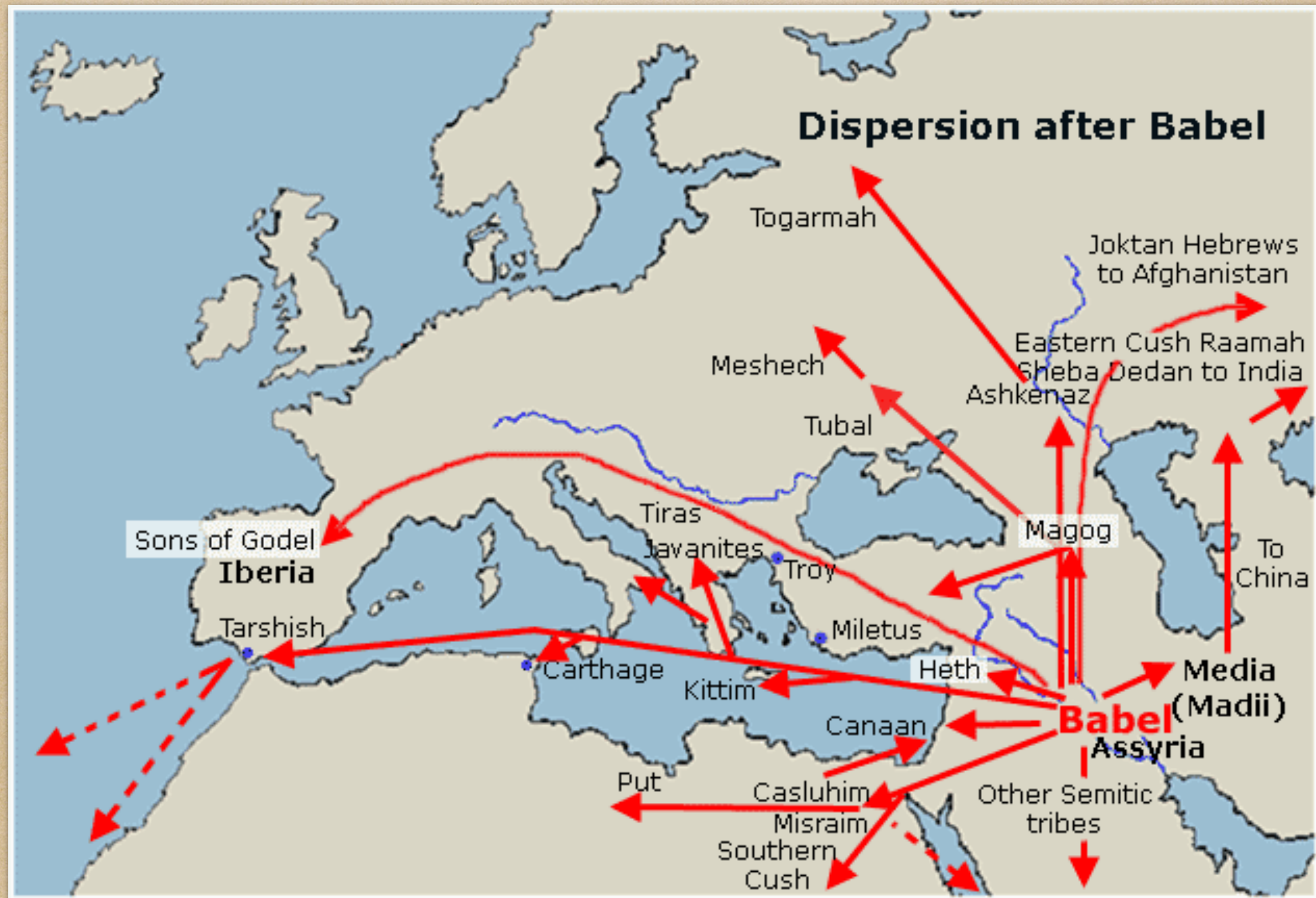

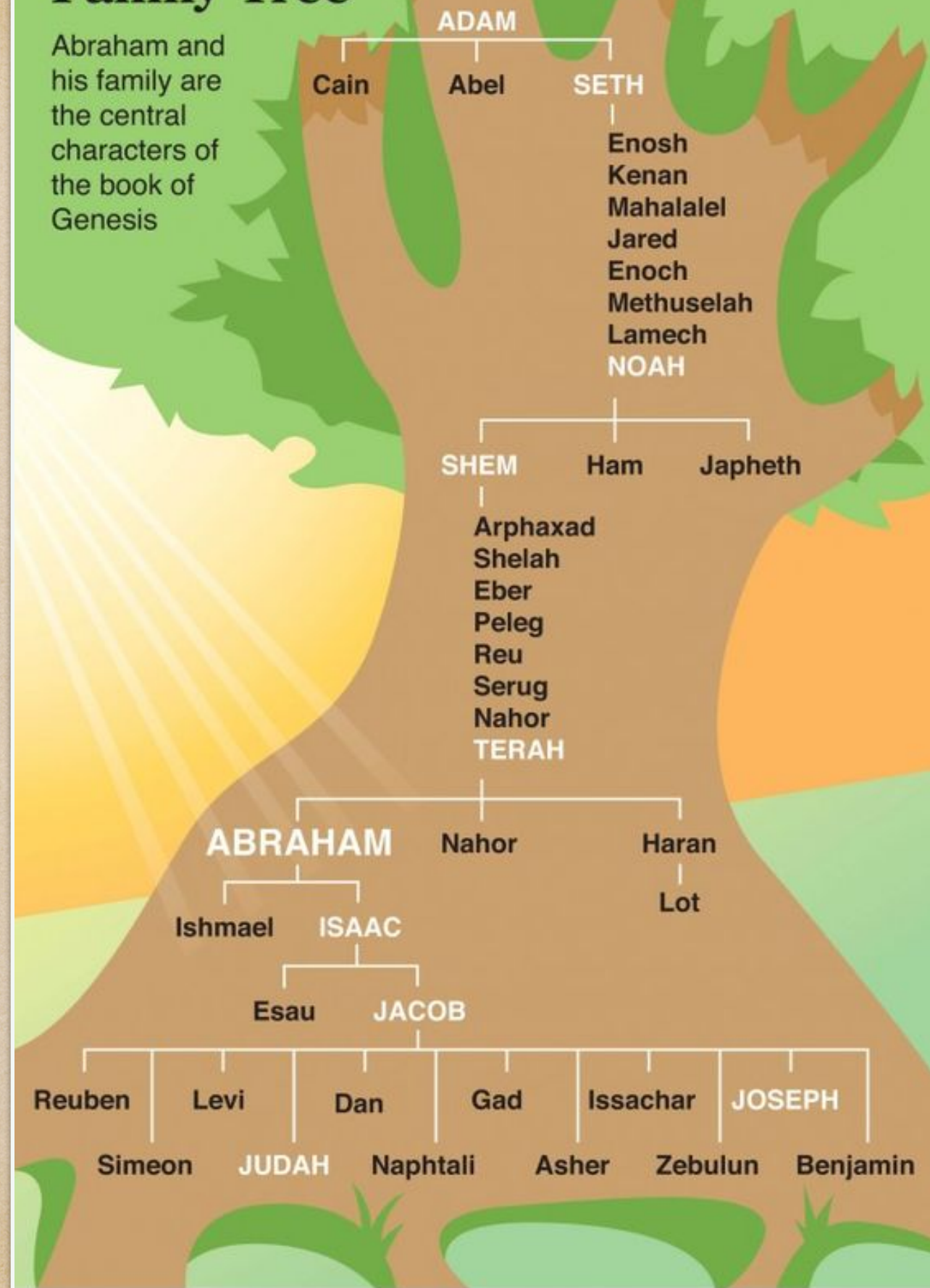

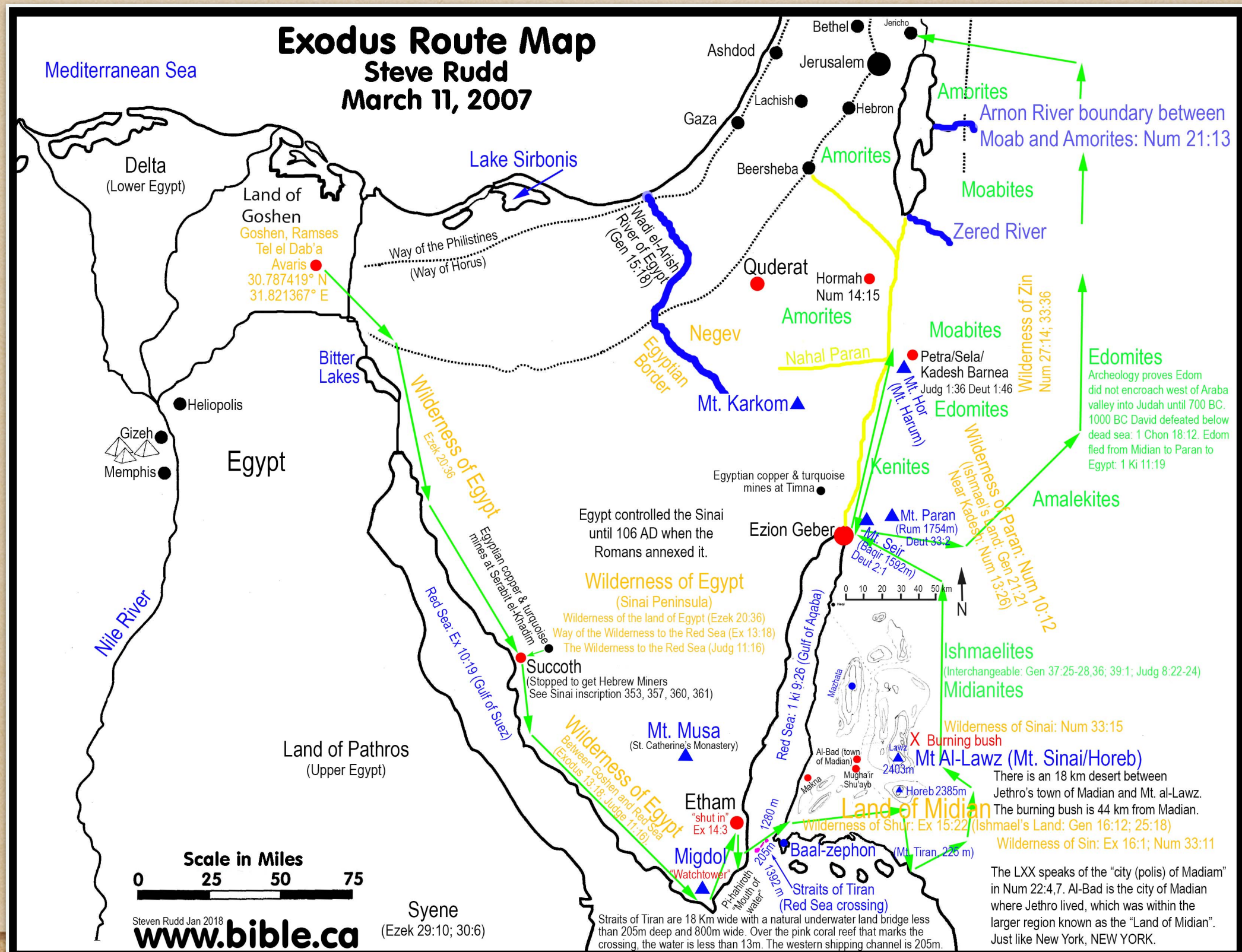

Exodus 28:17 - And thou shalt set in it settings of stones, even four rows of stones: the first row shall be a **sardius**, a **topaz**, and a **carbuncle**: this shall be the first row. And the second row shall be an **emerald**, a **sapphire**, and a **diamond**. And the third row a **ligure**, an **agate**, and an **amethyst**. And the fourth row a **beryl**, and an **onyx**, and a **jasper**: they shall be set in gold in their inclosings.

Estoraque: é o famoso e valioso bálsamo aromático da Ásia Menor; extraído da resina produzida por arbustos da família das Estiráceas

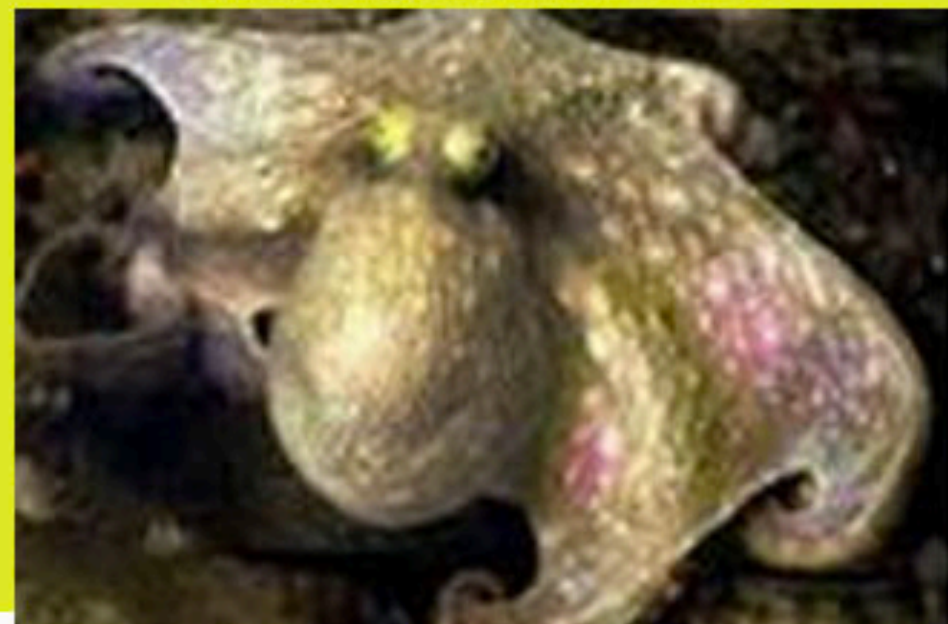

A Onicha era um molusco retirado do fundo do mar para ser queimado. Após a queima, ela produzia um cheiro agradabilíssimo.



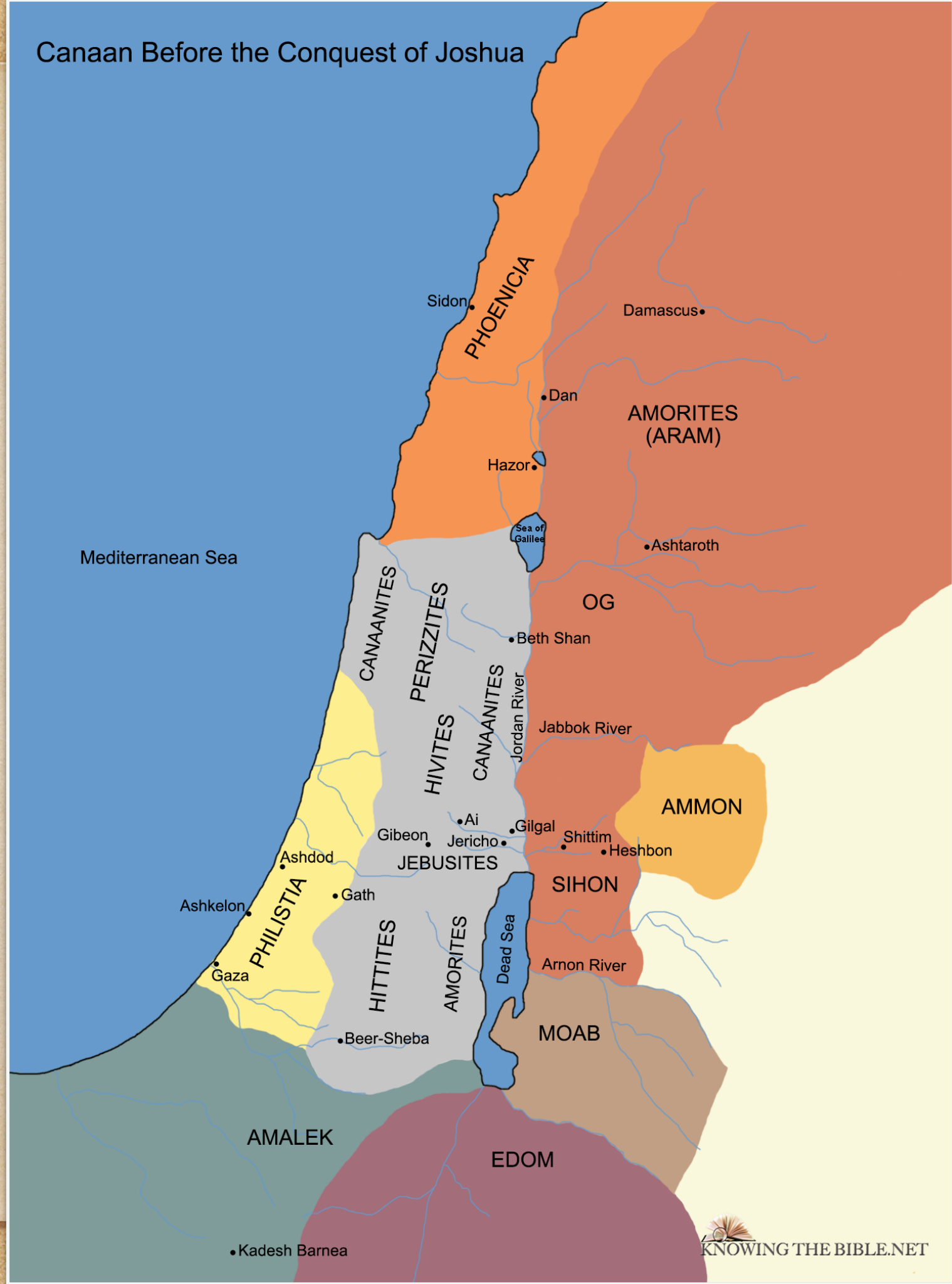
O gálbano é um arbusto que só exalava seu delicioso perfume após ser machucado, ser muito amassado.,

Kingdom of David

David Fulfills Land Promise to Abraham: Gen 15:18

1003-1001 BC 2 Samuel 8-11

1. Captures Gath, the chief city of the Philistine pentapolis.
2. Defeats Moab, killing 2/3's of the men by "measuring line"
3. Defeats Zobah when he captures the city of Berothai, kills 21,700 and defeats Hadadezer, the son of Rehob king
4. Kills 22,000 Aramean mercenaries who came to aid of Zobah.
5. Abishai the son of Zeruiah, Defeats Edom in the Salt Sea valley and kills 18,000 Aramean mercenaries helping Edom.
6. David writes Psalm 60 about the event.
7. Toi king of Hamath willingly submits to David, bringing him greetings and gifts.
8. David uses all the silver and gold he plundered in the temple.
9. Philistia was an ally to David because Tyre supplied the materials and skilled labour to build his house and the temple.
10. Nahash, king of Ammon was an ally of David and also the grandfather of Joab, Davids army commander. Nahash dies and his son breaks the covenant of peace causing war.
11. In 1001 BC, After the battle against Ammon begins, David sleeps with Bathsheba while he sends Uriah to die with an arrow shot from top of the gate of Rabbah in Ammon.
12. In 1001 BC Ammon is defeated.
13. In 1001 BC the philistines are defeated in Gezer and Gath.
14. In 1001 BC, David fulfills the land promise to Abraham and rules from River of Egypt (wadi el-Arish) to the Euphrates.
15. Solomon born in 999 BC. (Absalom is 9 years old)
16. In 990 BC, Tamar raped by 20 year old Amnon.
17. In 979 BC, 29 year old Absalom usurps David's throne and is killed by Joab a few weeks later.

Jeroboam I: Led secession of Israel

Rehoboam: Son of Solomon; first king

Nadab: Son of Jeroboam I

Abijah (Abijam; Abia): Son of Rehoboam

Baasha: Overthrew Nadab

Asa: Probably son of Abijah

Elah: Son of Baasha

Jehoshaphat: Son of Asa

Zimri: Overthrew Elah

Jehoram (Joram): Son of Jehoshaphat; husband of Athaliah

Omri: Overthrew Zimri

Ahaziah: Son of Jehoram and Athaliah

Ahab: Son of Omri; husband of Jezebel

Athaliah: Daughter of King Ahab of Israel and Jezebel; wife of Jehoram; only queen to rule over Judah

Ahaziah: Son of Ahab

Joash (Jehoash): Son of Ahaziah

Jehoram (Joram): Son of Ahab

Amaziah: Son of Joash

Jehu: Overthrew Jehoram

Uzziah (Azariah): Son of Amaziah

Jehoahaz (Joahaz): Son of Jehu

Jotham: Regent, later King; son of Uzziah

Jehoash (Joash): Son of Jehoahaz

Ahaz: Son of Jotham

Jeroboam II: Son of Jehoash

Hezekiah: Son of Ahaz; husband of Hephzi-Bah

Zechariah: Son of Jeroboam II

Manasseh: Son of Hezekiah and Hephzi-Bah

Shallum: Overthrew Zechariah

Amon: Son of Manasseh

Menahem: Overthrew Shallum

Josiah (Josias): Son of Amon

Pekahiah: Son of Menahem

Jehoahaz (Joahaz): Son of Josiah

Pekah: Overthrew Pekahiah

Jehoiakim: Son of Josiah

Hoshea: Overthrew Pekah; kingdom overthrown by Assyrians under Sargon II

Jehoiachin: Son of Jehoiakim
